### The Project

Responding to demands from our University community, The Center for Public Deliberation is continuing a project to address the classroom environment and content within postsecondary education. So, we've developed a strategy to empower students to think critically as well as creatively about their education as they grow and develop throughout the walk of their college experience.

Our goal is to assemble **a focus group of 20-30 student participants**; with about **2-3 students** representing their college at meetings, creating dialogue and action steps to improve higher education.

Student participants will attend a series of four meetings to discuss varied topics of higher education such as appreciations, concerns, solutions, and enhancements. Specific actions steps will be developed in addition to a written report which will be prepared after the series and distributed to staff, students and administrations.
