**The Department of Communication Studies is pleased to inform you of our National Communication Association affiliated honor society at Colorado State University. Lambda Pi Eta, the undergraduate honor society of NCA, has designated that our chapter be named – Mu Sigma.**

**To be eligible for individual Student Membership, a student must:**

1. Have completed 60 semester credit-hours (90 quarter credit-hours)
2. Have a minimum overall cumulative GPA of 3.0
3. Have completed the equivalent of 12 semester credit-hours (18 quarter credit-hours) in Communication Studies
4. Have a minimum GPA of 3.25 for all Communication Studies courses
5. Currently be enrolled as a student in good standing, as determined by the institution's policies

**Now that you are informed of the Mu Sigma Chapter, this letter serves as an invitation to each of you who meet the eligibility requirements to apply for student membership of this National Honor Society. Each applicant is responsible for supplying validation of their GPA (as of Fall Semester, 2022) and completed hours, along with an unofficial transcript/Degree Progress Audit. In addition, all qualified students are asked to submit a letter of interest that clearly explains how the student demonstrates commitment to the field of communication. If receiving this notice via e-mail, please download the application form that has been provided as an attachment & complete.**

**Upon review of the applicant's documentation of meeting the membership criteria and their letter of interest, the faculty advisor will inform each applicant of their standing. A one-time \$30.00 membership fee will be charged to those students who are eligible and interested in becoming a lifetime member of the Mu Sigma Chapter of Lambda Pi Eta. Each inductee will receive a pin & certificate from the National Communication Association and will participate in a Department of Communication Studies Induction Ceremony. Honor cords will be available for graduation.**

**The faculty encourage all eligible Communication Studies majors to apply. Please respond as soon as possible if you are scheduled to graduate in December 2022 or May 2023. An induction ceremony will be scheduled in late November/early December to accommodate Dec 2022 graduates. A yearly induction ceremony will be scheduled for this academic year in late April 2023.**
