Oil City News, Cap City News, and County 17 are excited to announce that they are now accepting applications for their internship program for the summer of 2024. These supervised positions are available for anyone 18 years of age or older to work as full- or part-time community reporters, photographers, or members of our sales team.

The Community Reporter Intern (General Assignment) will write stories daily, proactively working to increase visibility and reader engagement while also providing timely and accurate information. This person will be an active participant within the community and serve as the voice of one of the area's fastest growing news platforms.

The **Photo or Video Journalist Intern** is responsible for shooting feature content daily and using their visual storytelling skills to deliver timely and accurate information to the local community. Essential functions of the job include photographing community members, shooting community events, and creating short visual feature stories.

The Marketing/Sales Specialist must have a passion for Wyoming, the community, and its people and be able to succeed in a small business environment. This person will work hard to help our customers' businesses grow by developing relationships with existing and new partners, closing advertising and sponsorship deals, and identifying and creating new marketing collaborations to benefit local advertisers and brands.

The program is slated to begin after Memorial Day and run a minimum of ten weeks. Oil City News, Cap City News, and County 17 are also offering opportunities to customize the experience to a particular school's requirements for summer intern credit. In addition to real-world experience interns will gain daily, the news teams provide flexible scheduling, professional mentoring and generous stipends (up to \$15 per hour) for full-time intern team members.

Interested candidates can apply for these positions by submitting a résumé and letter of interest describing which position(s) they are most interested in and why they think they have what it takes to be a member of the team. Examples of prior creative work are always appreciated. The deadline to apply for the internship is **April 19, 2024**.
