**The Department of Communication Studies is pleased to inform you of our National Communication Association affiliated honor society at Colorado State University. Lambda Pi Eta, the undergraduate honor society of NCA, has designated that our chapter be named – Mu Sigma.**

**To be eligible for individual Student Membership, a student must:**

1. Have completed 60 semester credit-hours (90 quarter credit-hours)
2. Have a minimum overall cumulative GPA of 3.0
3. Have completed the equivalent of 12 semester credit-hours (18 quarter credit-hours) in Communication Studies
4. Have a minimum GPA of 3.25 for all Communication Studies courses
5. Currently be enrolled as a student in good standing, as determined by the institution's policies

**In addition to informing you of the existence of the Mu Sigma Chapter, this letter serves as an invitation to each of you who meet the eligibility requirements to apply for student membership in this National Honor Society. Each applicant is responsible for supplying validation of their GPA and completed hours, along with an unofficial transcript/Degree Progress Audit, at the time of your application. In addition, all qualified students are asked to submit a letter of interest that clearly explains how the student demonstrates commitment to the field of communication. A onetime \$35.00 membership fee will be charged to those students who are eligible and interested in becoming a lifetime member of the Mu Sigma Chapter of Lambda Pi Eta. Each inductee will receive a certificate from the National Communication Association and will participate in a Department of Communication Studies Induction Ceremony. Honor cords will be purchased by the Department of Communication Studies for inductees, to be available for graduation.**
