CSU's Department of Communication Studies is pleased to inform you of our honor society, Lambda Pi Eta. Lambda Pi Eta is the [official honorary of the National Communication Association \(NCA\)](#), and we invite you to consider membership in our local chapter of this distinguished organization.

To be eligible for individual Student Membership in Lambda Pi Eta, a student must:

1. Have completed 60 semester credit-hours (90 quarter credit-hours)
2. Have a minimum overall cumulative GPA of 3.0
3. Have completed the equivalent of 12 semester credit-hours (18 quarter credit-hours) in Communication Studies
4. Have a minimum GPA of 3.25 for all Communication Studies courses
5. Currently be enrolled as a student in good standing, as determined by the institution's policies

In addition to informing you of the existence of CSU's [Mu Sigma Chapter](#), this letter serves as an invitation to each of you who meet the eligibility requirements to apply for membership in this National Honor Society. Each applicant is responsible for supplying validation of their GPA and completed hours, along with an unofficial transcript/Degree Progress Audit, at the time of your application. In addition, all qualified students are asked to submit a brief essay that clearly explains how they demonstrate **commitment to the field of communication**. Upon review of your application materials, the advisor will inform each applicant of their standing. A one-time \$35.00 membership fee will be charged to those students who are eligible and interested in becoming a lifetime member of the Mu Sigma Chapter of Lambda Pi Eta. If you are concerned about the \$35.00 membership fee, please contact Amanda about need-based scholarships offered by the department.

Each inductee will receive a certificate from the National Communication Association and will be celebrated at a department Induction Ceremony later this semester! Honor cords will be purchased by the Communication Studies Department and provided to inductees, so they can be worn with well-deserved pride at graduation.
